Four Counties in Colorado approved resolutions to nullify the NDAA A resolution was submitted to the Huerfano County Commissioners last October. What is the status of that?

I understand that a resolution was presented to your office by Bruce Kettler January 30, 2013. A copy is on the WAC site. **Evidence shows that you deferred your decision at that meeting, and then later, because of a statement from the Colorado Attorney General, you said that such a decision should be made by the judicial system.**

We are not happy with such a statement. It is for you to decide upon this matter, based upon facts, and law. These matters are open to discussion and debate, yet you have not afforded such to take place.

Bruce Kettler has passed on information to you that an attorney is willing to publicly debate the Attorney General. Why have you not been willing to involve yourself with discussion and debate?

Kindly enforce our constitutional rights granted by the second and tenth amendments of the US Constitution, and by the Supreme Court Ruling in favor of Sheriff Richard Mack.
